Stuart Gulliver was appointed Head of Corporate, Investment Banking and Markets (CIBM) and Group Investment Businesses in May 2006. He became a Group General Manager in August 2000 and was appointed to the Group Management Board in March 2004.

Mr Gulliver joined HSBC in 1980 and has held a number of key roles in the Group's dealing rooms in London, Hong Kong and Tokyo.

In 1994, he became Head of Treasury and Capital Markets in Hong Kong and, in 1996, for Asia-Pacific. In 2002 Mr Gulliver was appointed Head of Global Markets with responsibility for the HSBC Group's trading and sales for foreign exchange, fixed income, derivatives, precious metals, futures broking, and management of the balance sheet.

Mr Gulliver was named in May 2005 as one of BusinessWeek magazine's 'Stars of Europe: 25 Leaders at the Forefront of Change'.

Mr Gulliver is a Special Adviser to Dai Xianglong, Mayor of Tianjin, China and a former Governor of the People's Bank of China, and a member of the International Advisory Board created by President Gloria Arroyo of the Philippines.

Stuart Gulliver was born in Derby, England on 9 March 1959. He was educated at Oxford University and received a Masters Degree in Jurisprudence.
