Notes and terms

- 1 Following the release of the new GHG Protocol Scope 2 Guidance, we have revised our methodology for calculating carbon emissions to use the state-specific eGRID emission factors for our US operations until such time as we obtain supplier-specific emission factors. In 2015, we re-stated our comparatives and for 2014 our reported total carbon dioxide emissions and our carbon dioxide emissions per FTE have increased by 43,000 tonnes and 0.16 tonnes respectively.
- 2 HSBC stated in its Annual Report and Accounts 2015 (ARA) that it applied the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Scope 2 Guidance market based methodology.

 In fact, the statement in the ARA was incorrect and the data was actually based on HSBC's internal reporting guidelines. There is no impact to the reported numbers.
- 3 From 2016, HSBC applied the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Scope 2 Guidance market based methodology. Primary reason for the reduction in energy emissions is the adoption of market-based methodology (accounts for 67% of the reduction) plus on-going energy saving initiatives. For detailed breakdown of the energy emissions (tonnes) under market-based and location-based reporting, please refer to table below.
