He has previously held a range of risk and regulatory roles at the Bank of England and Prudential Regulation Authority where he supervised several large banking institutions, amongst other responsibilities. He developed regulation across many aspects of the financial system, including, market infrastructure, payments, banking prudential and conduct requirements, corporate governance, resolution planning and operational risk and resilience.
